### **Job description:**

The Evergreen Cultural Centre seeks a qualified, imaginative, resourceful and enthusiastic animation instructor to lead our *The Worlds of Animation* spring camp for six to eight participants between the ages of 7 and 11. The successful candidate will develop the day to day camp curriculum and guide participants through the art of stop motion animation, basic editing and other relevant activities. The instructor will be supported by at least four volunteers and by the Spring Camp Assistant.

**Program Description:** Participants will learn a variety of animation techniques ranging from flipbooks to building a Zoetrope. Then, they will use what they have learned to work together to make a short stop-motion animated film that they can take home on DVD to share with family and friends.

### **Qualifications:**

The successful candidate will be a dynamic, creative, independent and resourceful individual with a demonstrated interest in public engagement and educational program planning and delivery. The candidate will have the ability to work with participants of all ages and backgrounds. The candidate must possess or be prepared to obtain a valid criminal record check. First aid training is an asset. The position demands that the candidate have excellent written and verbal communication skills and organizational skills and advance knowledge of and experience with stop-motion animation techniques and character development. Experience with iMovie, Final Cut Pro v. 10 and Canon AX10 video camera operation is an asset.
